My paintings are inspired by the Fauvist movement of the early 1900s, showcasing a vivid, expressionistic, and non-naturalistic use of color. My hope is that we are left infused with what William Wordsworth called, "that blessed mood, in which the burthen of the mystery, in which the heavy and the weary weight of all this unintelligible world, is lightened."
